CDC

CDC partnered with Innovation Central Canberra on a sustainability innovation project focused on Net Zero Water and enhancing the efficiency of data centre infrastructure.

The project involved a comprehensive research study that was completed successfully and will be followed by research throughout 2024 into a technology solution that will leverage heat rejection of condenser fans to improve the sustainability performance of data centres.

University of Canberra

Campus Estate

ICC and the University of Canberra Campus Estate team collaborated to develop a lifecycle asset management dashboard. Utilising available datasets and existing software, the end result resulted in a solution to provide the team insight into an effective long-term capital asset management plan.

Service Improvement

Student associates worked closely with the UC Web and Service Improvement teams to create an automated online service development catalogue, allowing UC staff to navigate service offerings across the university. In addition to their project requirements, students utilised Llama 2 to munch existing data and develop a POC chatbot function to be embedded in the service catalogue.



Cyber Security

ICC Student Associates developed “SafeClick”, which aims to mitigate phishing attacks and educate users to make secure online decisions. By integrating information on past breaches from a number of sources including the Cisco Umbrella database, users are empowered to make more informed evaluations of a websites safety, fostering awareness about the consequences of data breaches.
